



**National Selection Criteria for the
Summer World University Games – G4
(17-23/07/2025 - Rhine -Ruhr - Germany)**

1. General Information

1.1 Championship Date

The 2025 Taekwondo Summer World University Games (2025 SWUG) will take place from 17-23/07/2025

1.2 Venue

Rhine - Ruhr (Germany)

1.3 Eligibility

To participate in the 2025 SWUG, the taekwondoin must:

- Hold a valid GAL.
- Be affiliated with a federation member of the Belgian Taekwondo Federation.
- Be of Belgian nationality.
- Hold a Kukkiwon-delivered Dan certificate.
- Be born between 01/01/2000 and 31/12/2007.
- Be a student in higher education (University or Higher Education Institution) pursuing a degree (bachelor or master's) in the current academic year (2024-2025) (Note: evening courses leading to a bachelor's degree are also valid) or must have graduated from higher education in 2024.

1.4 Weight Categories

The weight categories open to selection are:

Women: -46, -49, -53, -57, -62, -67, -73, +73 kg
Men: -54, -58, -63, -68, -74, -80, -87, +87 kg

1.5 Number of Athletes Selected per Category

Only one taekwondoin per category and nation must be selected.

1.6 Registration Deadline

The registration deadline for selected taekwondoins is 16/05/2025.

1.7 Selection Period

The selection period starts on 13/02/2025 to 04/05/2025 included.

2. National Selection Criteria

To be eligible to participate in the 2025 SWUG, in addition to meeting the WT prerequisites (see 1.3), the Belgian taekwondoin must meet at least the following conditions.

2.1 Results in G1-G2-G3 opens

The taekwondoin must:

- a) have won a medal in a senior G1/G2/G3 open during the selection period
and
- b) he must have earned at least 7 points from 3 tournaments (sum of points based on the points system used for the WT world ranking - Table 1) during the selection period.

(*) Only applicable for Grand Prix Challenge

Notes:

- A result will only be considered if at least one fight was won during the relevant tournament.
- The taekwondoin will be selected in the weight category where they fulfilled the selection criteria.
- The three best results must have been achieved in the same WT weight category. Results obtained in different WT categories cannot be combined.

2.2 In Case of a Tie

If multiple taekwondoins have met the minimum selection criteria (2.1) for participation in the 2025 SWUG in the same weight category, one or more additional selection conditions are required, in order of priority:

- a) The taekwondoin who reaches the top 8 of the WT world ranking (not cleaned up) published in May 2025 in the relevant category will be selected.
- b) In case of a tie, if multiple taekwondoins are in the top 8, the taekwondoin with the highest number of points accumulated over 3 selection G1-G2-G3 opens (based on the points awarded in the WT ranking – table 1) during the selection period (see 1.7) will be selected. Results will only be considered if they were achieved in the same weight category and if at least one fight was won during the relevant tournament.



- c) In case of a new tie (in points), the taekwondoist with the highest position in the WT world ranking in the relevant category in May 2025 will be selected.

3. Deliberation

The national selection committee may select a taekwondoist based on a case analysis oriented towards the chances of success (deliberation). This deliberation is not automatic, it is at the discretion of the Technical Director of the said taekwondoist's federation.

3.1 Deliberation for a Taekwondoist Who Met the Selection Criteria

The national selection committee may propose to a non-selected taekwondoist (who has met the selection criteria – see 2) to compete in the higher or lower weight category, provided that this category is vacant.

3.2 Deliberation for a Taekwondoist Who Did Not Meet the Selection Criteria

A taekwondoist who did not meet the direct selection criteria (see 2) may still be selected through deliberation if they satisfy at least the following condition:

- reaching at least 2 quarterfinals, after having won 1 fight each time, during the selection period (see 1.7)

3.3 Factors Considered in Deliberation

The deliberation is a multifactorial analysis of the taekwondoist and their environment, oriented towards the chances of success. It takes into account the following (non-exhaustive list):

- Competition level.
- Number of fights won.
- Level of opponents they faced.
- Level of opponents they defeated.
- Results achieved in other weight categories.
- Weight stability.
- Body fat percentage.
- Standing height.
- Taekwondoist's age in the category.
- Training environment.
- Progression potential between the registration deadline and the target event.
- Place in the world and Olympic ranking.
- ...

4. Validation of the Selection

The National Selection Committee validates the selection based on these criteria.

Note:

Selected taekwondoists must continue their training program to tackle the SWUG 2025 in optimal shape. If prolonged or repeated absences from training result in a decline in competition level, the selection may be suspended or canceled.
